4. Tokyo 2017 Insolvency Law Commission session

5. Cooperation with other Commissions

Marco Lenti of the Transport Law Commission joined the meeting and explained the intention to hold a joint seminar on Hanjin and insolvency in the transport sector, in the weekend of 28-30 September 2017 in Bilbao.
